A climate responsive agricultural sector in the Caribbean.

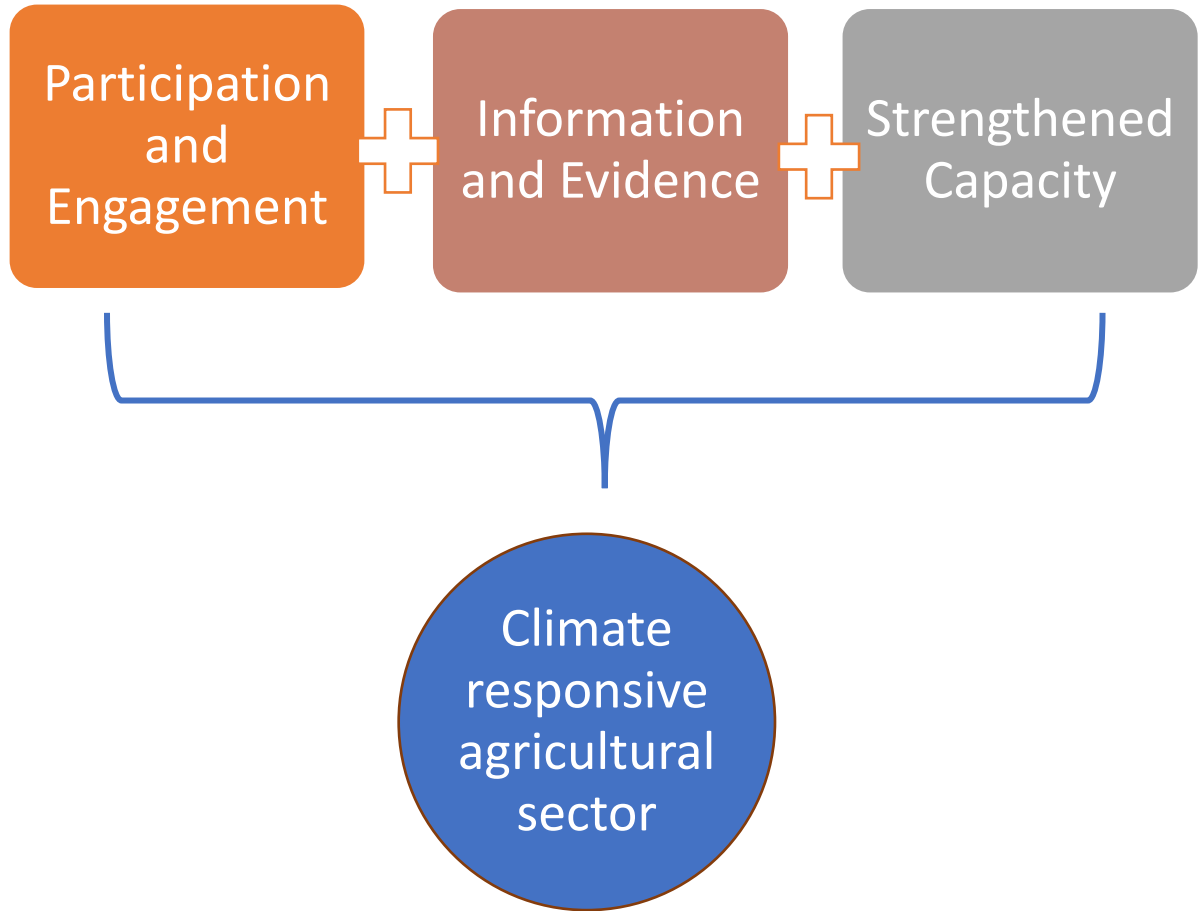
Theory of Change Statement
