Grenada

- The capabilities of five rural groups (including 18 members of the Alliance constituents) to expand their individual membership and to improve the livelihood of their members have been enhanced after training in project development and the preparation of project profiles.
- The Grenada Organic Agriculture Movement (GOAM), endorsed by the Ministry of Agriculture, was established and is functioning as a facilitating entity for the promotion and development of organic agriculture in Grenada.
- Twenty agriculture technicians and eighteen potential organic producers increased their knowledge of, and capabilities in organic agriculture through participation in an intensive workshop: “Development of National Standards for Organically Produced Foods” and the definition of recommendations for the way forward for organic agriculture in Grenada.
- The technical capability of twenty banana producers and sixteen agriculture technicians was enhanced as a result of exposure to *ad hoc* groups for ‘fair trade’ and to several reports related to banana cultivation and value added products. This was carried out in support of the re-organization and modernization of Grenada’s banana industry.
