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
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INTRODUCCION

El Suplemento no. 1, Bibliografía del Frijol (Phaseolus spp.) ha sido preparado para dar acción de continuidad al cumplimiento de una de las recomendaciones emanadas de las reuniones del Proyecto Cooperativo Centroamericano del Mejoramiento del Frijol.

A fin de darle un alcance mayor al contenido de este Suplemento establecimos el criterio de incluir en él, no solamente la literatura recibida en la Biblioteca Conmemorativa Orton -tal como se hizo en la bibliografía básica- sino que se procedió a hacer una investigación complementaria en un número selecto de índices bibliográficos agrícolas, 1964-68.

El crecimiento de la producción de publicaciones sobre frijol en los años recientes, y esta dimensión más amplia que se le ha dado al contenido del Suplemento, se evidencia en la extensión de las dos bibliografías:

Bibliografía básica, incluye todos los materiales existentes en la Biblioteca Conmemorativa Orton hasta aproximadamente Junio 1965 = 3.006 referencias bibliográficas.

Suplemento no. 1, incluye materiales que corresponden, en su mayor parte, a los años 1965 a 1968 = 1.363 referencias bibliográficas.

La Bibliografía está organizada por grandes tópicos; su estructura sigue el esquema de clasificación que se adoptó para la bibliografía básica; se han introducido algunas modificaciones, unificando, suprimiendo o agregando nuevos encabezamientos de materia.

Dentro de cada materia las referencias bibliográficas están arregladas en orden alfabético de autores. La bibliografía se acompaña de una detallada tabla de contenido de materias y un índice de autores.

El Servicio de Reproducción de Documentos de la Biblioteca Conmemorativa Orton, permite a los especialistas agrícolas el acceso rápido y fácil a todas las publicaciones registradas en esta bibliografía.

INTRODUCTION

In order to continue with the fulfilment of one of the recommendations emanated from the "Proyecto Cooperativo Centroamericano del Mejoramiento del Frijol" the Supplement no. 1 to the Bean Bibliography (Phaseolus spp.) was compiled.

This Supplement includes, not only all literature on bean received at the Orton Memorial Library, as it was in the original bibliography, but to widening the contents of the bibliography an additional research was made in a selected number of bibliographical agricultural indexes, 1964-68.

The increase of publications on bean in recent years and the wider dimension of the content of the Supplement are shown in the following figures:

Basic bibliography, includes all the materials received in the Orton Memorial Library approximately to June 1965 = 3.006 bibliographical references.

Supplement no. 1, includes bibliographical entries which cover, in a major part, the years 1965-68 = 1.363 bibliographical references.

This Supplement maintains the same classification scheme of the original work. However, in some cases, similar subjects were included under one heading, and in others new subdivisions were made whenever necessary.

Under each subject the bibliographical references are arranged alphabetically by author. The bibliography has a detailed table of contents by subject and also an author index.

The Reproduction of Documents Service of the Orton Memorial Library offers to the agricultural scientific community an easy and quickly access to all the publications included in this bibliography.

Our acknowledgement to the North Carolina State University Mission and to Dr. Eddie Echandi -who is actually associated with the Mission- for their cooperation in making possible the publication of this work.
