By means of letter SC/DG-053, dated January 19, 2001, the Director General requested the Member States of the Institute to express their interest in nominating candidates for representing the Inter-American Board of Agriculture (IABA) on the Governing Council of the Tropical Agriculture Research and Higher Education Center (CATIE).

Because no nominations were received, the Executive Committee, at its Twenty-first Regular meeting, requested the Government of Jamaica, current representative of the IABA to the Governing Council of CATIE, to accept an extension of its appointment until October 2001. Jamaica accepted.

In view of the above, the Executive Committee recommended, by Resolution N° 360, that the Inter-American Board of Agriculture (IABA), at its Eleventh Regular Meeting, approve the extension of the appointment of Mr. Roger Clarke of Jamaica, to represent the IABA on the Governing Council of CATIE, for another two-year term.
