

#### **FOREWORD**

The world has entered a new and very dynamic information age exemplified by Internet and the World Wide Web. The following partial bibliography focuses on natural resources, the environment and related areas in Guyana. This is of particular importance at this point in time when so many new projects are being initiated and development plans are being formulated. IICA is extremely pleased to contribute to the development process of the rural sector with this new publication.

The compiler of this bibliography, Macsood Hoosein, is to be congratulated for this time consuming effort. Mr. Hoosein was awarded a six-month scholarship under IICA's Junior Professional Program in 1994-95. #### INTRODUCTION

This bibliography is based on the holdings of the following libraries:

- the Caribbean Research Library, University of Guyana (CRL/UG);
- the Information and Documentation Centre of the Guyana Natural Resources Agency (GNRA);
- the National Library (NL);
- the Guyana Forestry Commission (GFC) Library; and
- the Library of the Guyana Agency for Health Sciences Education, Environment and Food Policy (GAHEF).

It is not exhaustive, since not all the libraries in Guyana were visited, and it is a certainty that the libraries researched did not have all the literature on the subject of this bibliography. Further, it includes only those documents that were actually in the collections of the libraries inventoried, that is, it was not based on the catalogue information, which may be different from the collection currently on the shelves, a situation that may result due to loss or new acquisitions, or both.

An attempt was made to annotate as many of the more important entries within the limitations imposed by the time factor.

Of the libraries involved, the CRL had the largest collection. It should be noted that other departmental libraries at the University of Guyana have information in Journal or other sources on Guyana but which may not be present in the collections of the CRL. These departmental libraries were not inventoried in the compilation of this work. It is instructive to note, also, that a data base on the biological diversity of Guyana, as well as the process of the recovery and compilation of information on the biological diversity of Guyana, is presently being prepared by the Institute of Applied Science and Technology. It is also reported that the Centre for the Study of Biological Diversity of the University of Guyana is presently compiling a data base on its holdings in the area of biological diversity. Additionally, locations like the Iwokrama International Rain Forest Programme, the Centre for the Study of Biodiversity and the Project Preparation Unit of the EPA/NPAS house collections on the subject of this bibliography.

In the compilation of this bibliography, the subject of agriculture, despite its obvious relation to the environment, was not included. However, the bibliographies on agriculture that were encountered have been included in the "Bibliographies" section. Entomology, though it is related to wildlife and biology, was not included in this bibliography because it is regarded as a branch of the field of agriculture. Similarly, for the field of Acarology.

One of the sub-headings listed is that of "Natural History" because of its relation to natural resources and the environment. However, most of the literature on the subject was found to be travelogues and more descriptive than technical. Only the more technical documents were included in this bibliography. The reader interested in the other documents can consult the "List of books on travel in Guyana", compiled by the Department of Modern Languages of the University of Guyana, listed in the "Bibliography" section of this document. A number of the travelogues and books on natural history can be found at the National Library.

This bibliography is divided into sections which are arranged in alphabetical order. These are: Bibliographies; Biology; Botany; Charcoal and Wood Energy; Environment; Fisheries; Forestry; Hydrology/Climate; Iwokrama; Land Use; Mangroves and Coastal Zone; Natural History; Natural Resources; Non-timber Forest Products (which includes cultivated food and medicinal plants); Physical Geography; Policy and Legislation; Protected Areas; Soils; and Wildlife.

The entries follow the bibliographic format presented below, except in the case of Journals, which retained their own formats:

Name of author(s); Title; Publisher and location; Date of publication; Number of pages; Any relevant annotations; One library where it can be found (acronym in parenthesis). Annotations, summarizing the more important contents of each entry, where they occur, immediately follow the entry in indented paragraph(s) and in slightly smaller print.

Based on the findings, survival of greenheart seedlings in full shade is expected to be low, and the species will not be able to maintain a seedling bank. Greenheart is expected to need a gap in an early stage of its life cycle. It is generally concluded that the species is more a shade avoiding than a shade tolerant species.

The purpose of the document is to examine the cost structure of the sawmilling industry in Guyana and the impact on the financial viability of the industry of changes in royalty rates and major variables such as product revenue. A hypothetical sawmill model was developed based on the establishment of a new mill capable of efficiently manufacturing sawnwood to international standards. The internal rate of return of the hypothetical mill, a key measure of financial viability, was used to assess the impact of changes in royalty rates and other variables.

Changes in royalty rates had very limited impact on financial viability. However, financial viability was very sensitive to small changes in product revenue, fairly sensitive to changes in capital costs, and less sensitive to increases in manufacturing costs and the cost of sawnlogs.
