IICA, which was created in 1942, is the agency of the Inter-American System specializing in agriculture and rural well-being.

The Institute aspires to be the leading, innovative institution in providing technical cooperation in agriculture, and to be recognized for its contribution to achieving competitiveness in the agrifood system, sustainable development of agriculture, food security, poverty reduction and improvement of living conditions in the rural territories of the Americas, thanks to its technical strength and its capacity to respond to the new challenges that its member countries are facing in their agricultural sectors.

IICA carries out its technical cooperation actions through six programs:



- Our actions in Education, Training and Leadership include the following:
 - Alliances with accredited university centres to jointly develop and offer doctoral, masters, diploma and specialist courses.
 - Training and leadership programs in areas such as rural development, senior agricultural management, modernization of university curricula and other programs, in conjunction with our strategic partners.
 - Distance education networks organized in specific nodes with strategic partners, in regions around the hemisphere and on the technical concentration topics of IICA.
 - Design of training activities in conjunction with the IICA Offices in the member countries, with the technical areas of IICA and with our strategic partners, including telepresence activities.
 - Visiting professionals initiatives that enable IICA to receive support from external professionals and postgraduate students in order to strengthen the capacity of the Institute to offer technical cooperation to the countries.
 - Scholarships for postgraduate studies in sustainable agriculture or other sciences related to the thematic areas of the Institute, thanks to an agreement with the Government of Mexico, via the National Council on Science and Technology (CONACYT).

Education, training and leadership

- In the area of Information and Communication Technologies, our actions include the following:
 - Networks and telecommunications. Administration of information management teams and networks as well as design and implementation of information and management systems.
 - Research and information systems. Support for governing and technical processes as well as development of applications.
 - Technical support. Distance service to staff and strategic partners; training and knowledge dissemination.
 - Telepresence. Technical support for organization of meetings, events and virtual technical fora.
