FIRST, WE IDENTIFIED THE NEED TO:

- Promote a coordinating entity of stakeholders for the competitive, fair and sustainable management of the chain
- Strengthen the capabilities of chain stakeholders in areas such as the development of strategies, organization and productivity, with an emphasis on small-scale producers
- Promote good poultry farming practices and food safety measures throughout the chain in order to mitigate the effects of pests and diseases

IN 2017 WE ARE **FOCUSING** ON:

- We strengthened the capacities of 205 actors throughout the chain in the areas of analysis of competiveness of the chain, good poultry production practices, and control and eradication of avian influenza and Newcastle disease
- We shared the experience of the Poultry Census conducted in Ecuador and Costa Rica and the identification of feed alternatives for poultry production via horizontal cooperation

- Strengthening capabilities for organizing, linking, and coordinating stakeholders within the chain
- Promoting innovations in order to reduce the negative effects of diseases and problems with food safety throughout the chain
- Developing and executing a capacity-building program focused on business management and organization
- Promoting horizontal cooperation to share successful experiences related to the growth of productivity and efficiency within the chain
