**ANTECEDENTES**

Una de las sugerencias presentadas en el desarrollo de los Seminarios-Taller llevados a cabo por el PNCA, hacía referencia a la necesidad de trabajar los aspectos relacionados con el manejo estadístico de la información pertinente a la capacitación.

En cumplimiento de esta recomendación, el PNCA organizó una actividad que permitiera trabajar la información por lo menos a tres niveles diferentes y complementarios entre sí: su recolección, su análisis y su presentación.

**OBJETIVOS**

El Seminario-Taller buscó que los participantes:

1. Estudiaran y manejaran los conceptos pertinentes al muestreo y su aplicación dentro de las necesidades institucionales de capacitación.
2. Determinaran los tamaños de muestra apropiados para la obtención de la información.
3. Practicaran algunos test estadísticos pertinentes al análisis de la información relacionada con capacitación (i.e: sondeos de necesidades, evaluaciones, seguimiento, etc.).
4. Conocieran y estudiaran técnicas de representación gráfica de información.

**DESARROLLO**

El Seminario-Taller fue eminentemente práctico con ejercicios relacionados con cada uno de los temas.

Aprovechando datos de INCORA se determinaron muestras y tamaños de muestras necesarias para procesos investigativos.

The report also mentions that the government is failing to invest in the military and that there is a widespread feeling of military insecurity.

8. The eighth part of the report discusses the future prospects. It is noted that the country is still in a state of depression and that the government is facing a serious financial crisis. The report also mentions that the population is suffering from widespread poverty and unemployment.
